\$5 PER WEEK

- A CHILD RECEIVES HEALTHY MEALS FOR ONE YEAR WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION.
- 120 NEW BOOKS FOR TEN PRESCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN FOR ONE YEAR.
- A HOME REPAIR PROJECT TO HELP A SENIOR ADULT (AGE 60+) MAINTAIN INDEPENDENCE IN THEIR HOME.



\$10 PER WEEK

- LEGAL SERVICES PROVIDED FOR A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.
- SHELTER, LIFE SKILLS TRAINING AND MENTORING FOR YOUTH AGES 16 - 23 WHO ARE TRANSITIONING OUT OF FOSTER CARE.
- COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH CARE FOR ONE YEAR (PRIMARY MEDICAL, MENTAL HEALTH AND DENTAL) FOR ONE INDIVIDUAL.



\$25 PER WEEK

- ACCESS TO MEDICATION, MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND COMMUNITY RESOURCES FOR ONE YEAR FOR 5 INDIVIDUALS.
- DIAPERS, SUPPLIES FOR MOTHER AND CHILD, AND FOOD FOR ONE YEAR FOR EIGHT EXPECTING AND NEW MOTHERS.



\$50 PER WEEK

- PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, SOCIAL AND EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR TWELVE PATIENTS LIVING WITH CANCER AND THEIR FAMILIES.
- ASSISTS TEN YOUTH (AGES 16-23) IN SECURING TRADE CERTIFIED EMPLOYMENT IN RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION, NURSING OR COMMERCIAL DRIVING.
- ONE YEAR OF PROGRAMMING AND SERVICES TO MAINTAIN HOUSING STABILITY FOR A HOMELESS FAMILY.
