THE VOLUNTEER CENTER

The Volunteer Center inspires, empowers, and enables residents and businesses to respond creatively and effectively to community needs through volunteering. We do this by working with local nonprofits to identify their volunteering needs, then recruiting volunteers to fill those needs.

RSVP is one of the largest volunteer networks in the nation for people 55 and over. RSVP acts as a liaison by connecting you to organizations who are working to meet the needs of the community.

PROJECT SPARK

Project SPARK (Successful Partnerships to Assure Readiness for Kindergarten) is a partnership between the Kansas City Kansas Public Schools (KCKPS) and five community nonprofit organizations.

YouthBuild KCK

This program provides pathways to jobs, education, entrepreneurship, and other opportunities by unleashing the positive energy of low-income young people to rebuild their communities and lives.

Emergency Assistance

UWWC administers emergency assistance programs that support Wyandotte County residents in times of crisis.

CARING CLUB: Cards are mailed to the home address provided. Cards cannot be mailed until pledges are received and processed by United Way.
